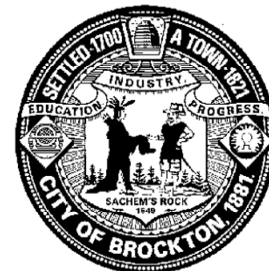


# BROCKTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS
