Brockton Public Schools Statement of Privacy

The Brockton Public Schools and Brockton Educational Foundation are committed to protecting your privacy. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Brockton Public Schools web site and governs data collection and usage at all Brockton Public Schools sites and services; it does not apply to other online or offline sites, products or services. Please read the Brockton Public Schools Statement of Privacy. Brockton Public Schools is a general audience web site, intended for users of all ages. Personal information of all users is collected, used and disclosed as described in this Statement of Privacy.

Collection of your Personal Information

As an E-commerce Web site, Brockton Public Schools collects personal information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. Information collected by Brockton Public Schools is used solely for the purpose of billing and shipping your online purchases. Brockton Public Schools does not collect any information about your computer hardware and software.

Brockton Public Schools encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from Brockton Public Schools so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. We are not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the Brockton Public Schools Web site.

Use of your Personal Information

Brockton Public Schools and its operational service partners collect and use your personal information to process product orders and deliver the products requested. It is possible that Brockton Public Schools may also use personal information to inform you of other products or services available from Brockton Public Schools and its affiliates. Brockton Public Schools may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Brockton Public Schools does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. Brockton Public Schools may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your personal information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party.

We occasionally hire other companies to provide limited services on our behalf, such as handling the processing and delivery of mailings, providing customer support, processing transactions, or performing statistical analysis of our services. We will only provide those companies the personal information they need to deliver the service. They are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information and are prohibited from using that information for any other purpose.

Brockton Public Schools does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

Brockton Public Schools may access and/or disclose your personal information if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Brockton Public Schools or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or

Brockton Public Schools abides by the safe harbor framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of data from the European Union.

Security of your Personal Information

Brockton Public Schools is committed to protecting the security of your personal information. We use a variety of security technologies and procedures to help protect your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. For example, we store the personal information you provide on computer systems with limited access that are located in controlled facilities. When we transmit highly confidential information (such as a credit card number) over the Internet, we use a secure payment gateway so your information is protected.

Changes to this Statement

Brockton Public Schools will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. If there are material changes to this Statement or in how Brockton Public Schools will use your personal information, Brockton Public Schools will prominently post such changes prior to implementing the change. Brockton Public Schools encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how Brockton Public Schools is protecting your information.
