NOTES:

1. Automatic failure on third absence per term (unless waived or buyback).
2. LET IIIA students must have a final average of "C-" or higher to continue in LET IIIB. LET IIIB students must have a final average of "B-" or higher to continue in LET IVA, an Advanced Level course.
3. For non-seniors and regular option seniors, a total of up to 10 extra credit points can be awarded for voluntary Service Learning classes and participation over course of the semester. These points will be added to the term grades as appropriate.
4. Seniors who choose to do so may participate in the LET IV semester service learning project. They must declare that option not later than the end of the third week of first term. Seniors who choose this option will be excused from the final exam, and will be graded under the senior option criterion. Bi-weekly after school service learning class participation is required. Missing more than one service learning class per term will result in automatic reassignment to the regular grading option.
5. LET III includes many self-study assignments. Cadets are responsible for completing reading and self-study written assignments on their own. As many of these assignments are not discussed in detail during class, additional research is encouraged to ensure understanding. THESE ASSIGNMENTS ARE TESTABLE.
