

TIPS FOR PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

AT THE CONFERENCE

Ask the teacher:

- What is my child learning this year?
- How is my child doing on homework assignments?
- What are my child's strengths and weaknesses?
- What kinds of tests do you give?
- What activities does my child enjoy most?
- How does my child get along with other students?
- Is my child doing the best he or she can do?
- Are there any special programs for my child?

THE TEACHER MAY HAVE SOME QUESTIONS, TOO

He or she may ask you about your child's likes and dislikes, study habits, etc. Your answers can help the teacher help your child.

MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR CONFERENCE

- Arrive on time.
- Relax.
- Raise your most important concerns first.
- Ask questions.
- Discuss ways to work as a team.
